These modifications are described in [Resolve](#), Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 587: In-stream Flow and Lake and Pond Water Levels, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Environmental Protection ([Resolves 2007 Ch. 63](#)). In the course of the legislative review process changes were also made to the enabling statute, Title 38, Section 470-H. These changes can be found in An Act To Coordinate the Implementation of the In-stream Flow and Water Level Rules among the Department of Environmental Protection, the Drinking Water Program of the Department of Health and Human Services and the Public Utilities Commission ([P.L. 2007 Ch. 235](#)).
